




Served around 40 individuals impacted by violence with small micro-grants.

We are not able to predict what could of happened had we not assisted, but we can definitely take this opportunity to reflect on all the amazing things that have happened because of this. This young man is now re-enrolled in school and looking to enter the construction trade. We will continue to work with him and do all we can to support his success, but I wanted to take some time to share this because everything you and your congregation does to support this effort is so vital and does not go unnoticed."

MENTAL HEALTH FUND








CITY KIDS




Attendance has nearly doubled.
